Construction industry reminded to comply with rules

PETALING JAYA: Developers and contractors are reminded to display the highest compliance required of them to reduce negative perception on the industry. All companies in the construction

industry must follow the standard operating procedure (SOP) to prevent the spread of Covid-19, says Real Estate and Housing Developers Association (Rehda) president Datuk Soam Heng Choon. He said employers need to ensure

the accommodation provided to their foreign workers follow standards and guidelines set by the authorities. "Employers must pay attention to

where their workers stay, not just foreign workers but also locals.

"Local workers usually wouldn't live in very crammed spaces but foreign workers don't mind because they want to save money to send home. "But it is tough for employers to

inspect each and every one of these living spaces if they are not provid-

ing them the accommodation.
"However, if the accommodation is provided by employers, then the onus is on them to ensure it complies with the minimum standards issued by the Labour Department," he said when contacted. Soam, however, said it was not

just the construction industry that could be blamed, adding that every employer should ensure proper

"To put it squarely on construction sites is not fair. It may be a
cluster but if you look, there are
foreign workers in other places too
like shopping malls and the virus

"So employers, especially in the construction industry, must play their role and comply with regulations," he said.

Soam said adoption of the SOP and measures was part of the new

normal in the workplace.

He urged all developers to work closely with stakeholders to play their role and help contain the spread of Covid-19.
