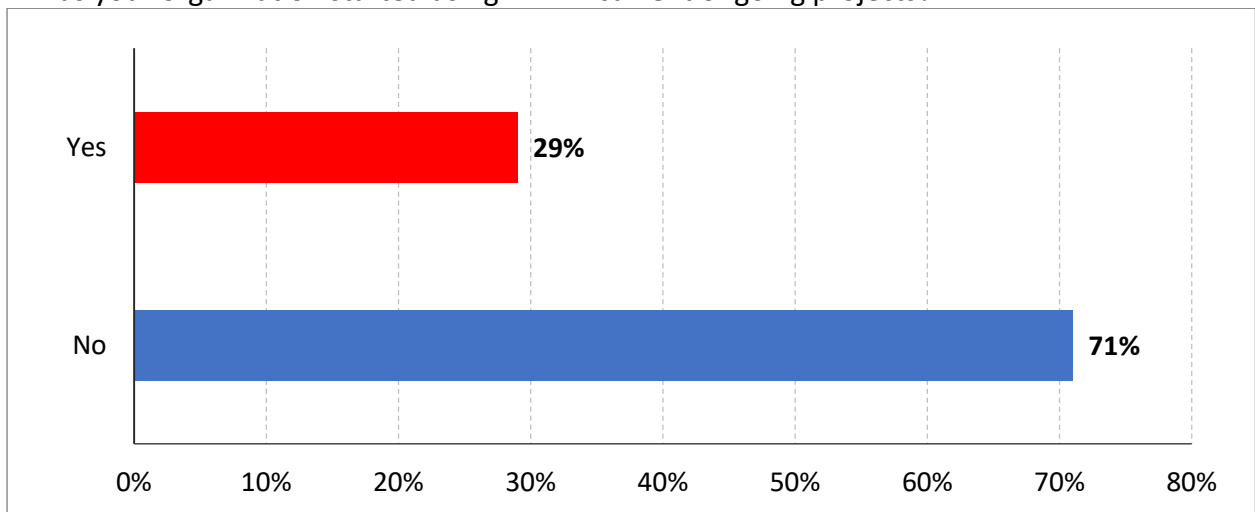

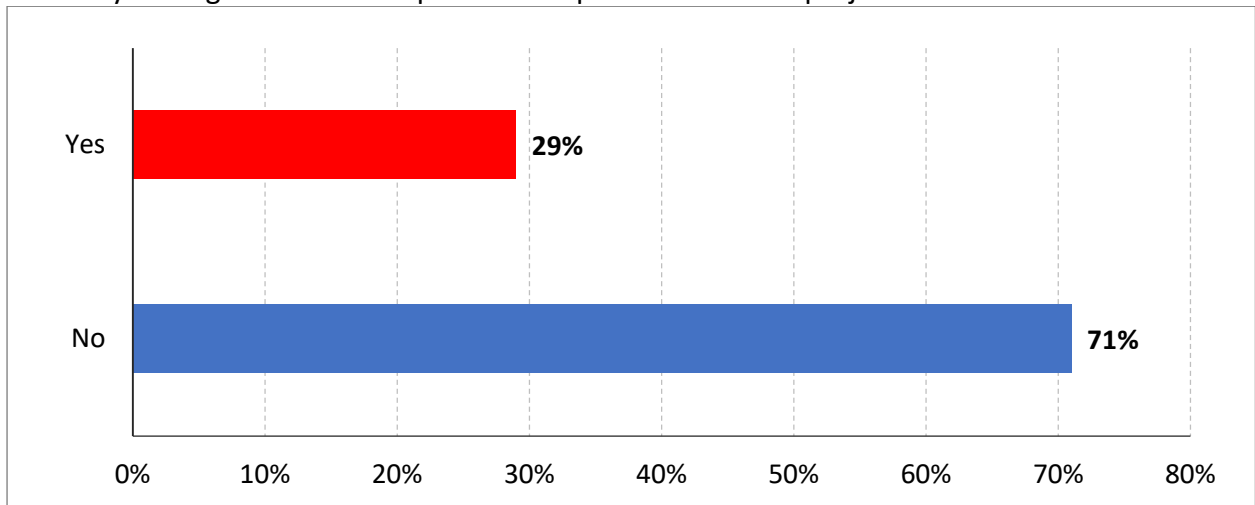

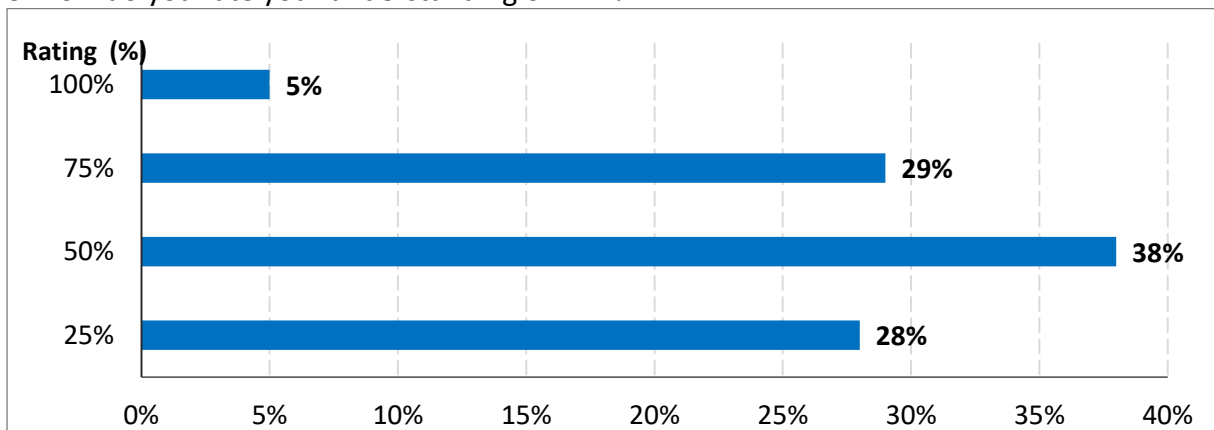
1. Has your organization started using BIM in current ongoing projects?



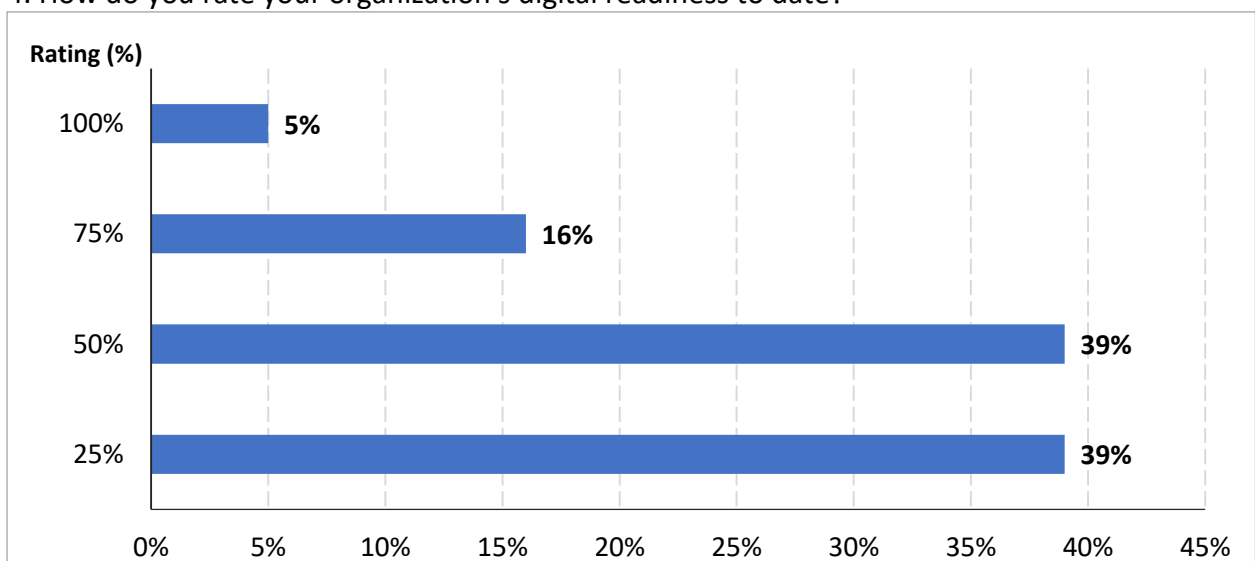
2. Does your organization have plans to adopt BIM for future projects?



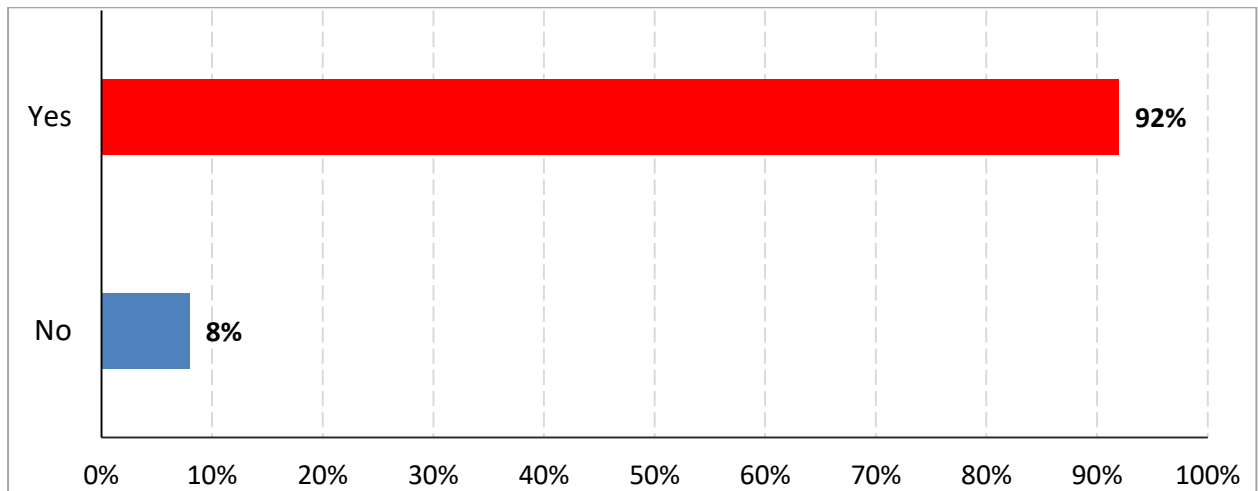
3. How do you rate your understanding of BIM?



4. How do you rate your organization's digital readiness to date?



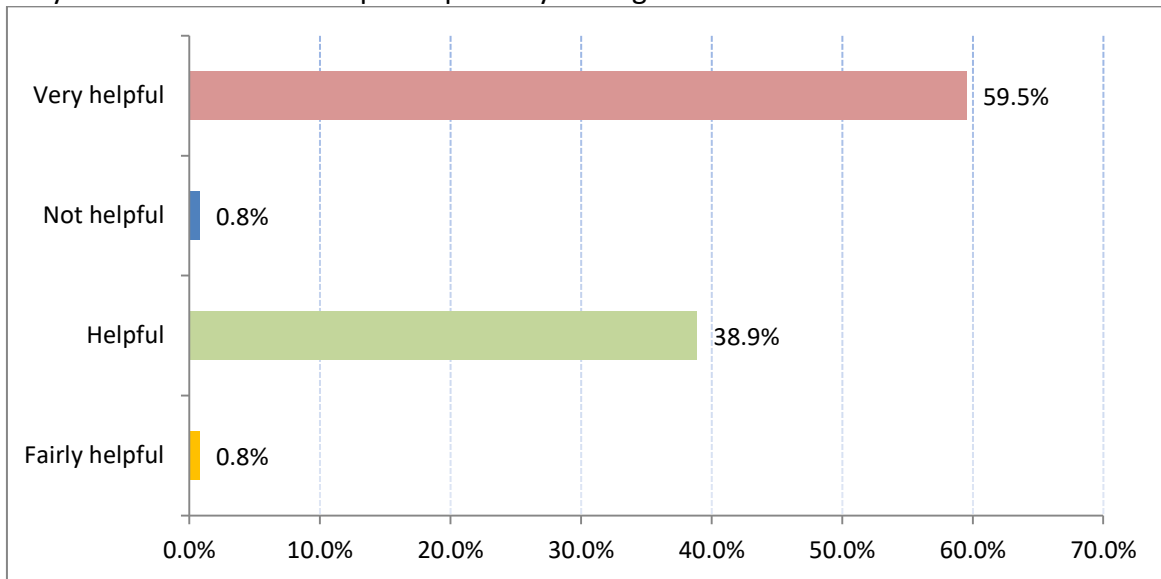
5. Do you find the need for your organization to invest in migrating its hardcopy/analogue data into digital formats for your organization's day-to-day operations?



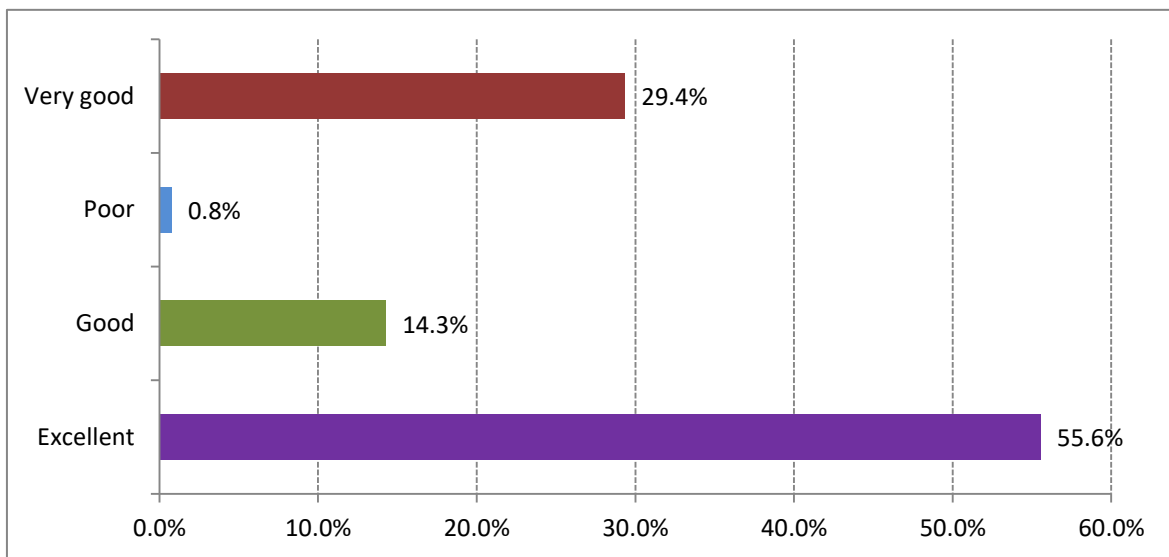

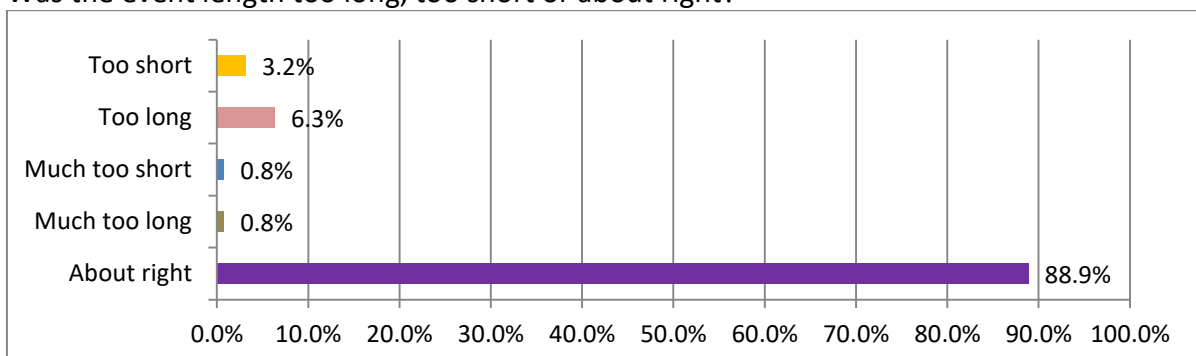
1) Do you find this webinar topic helpful to your organization?



2) How would you rate the presenter on the subject matter?

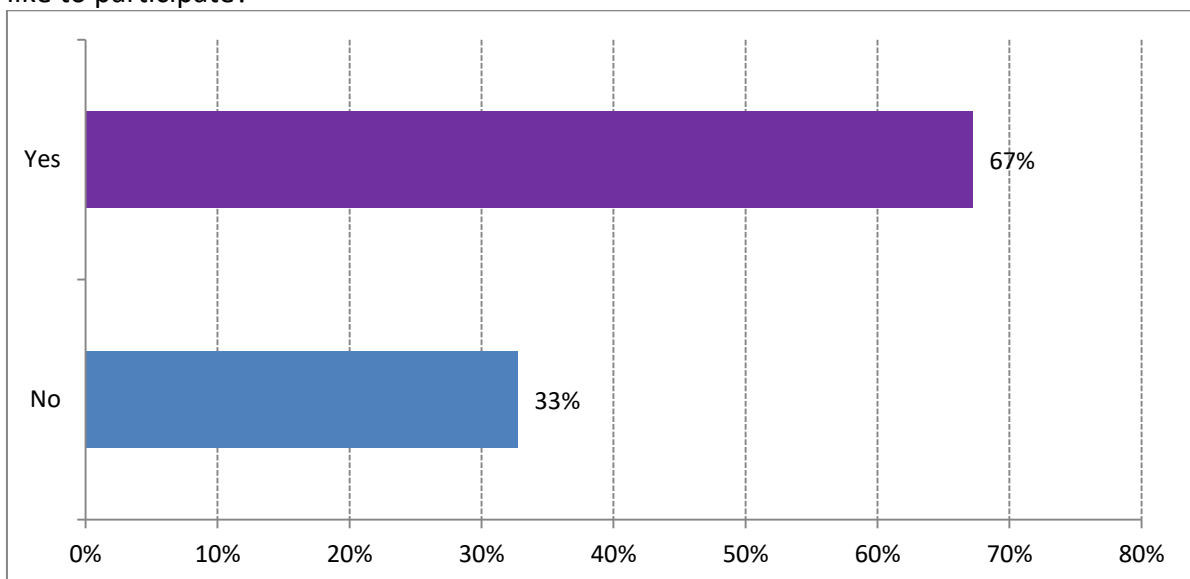
