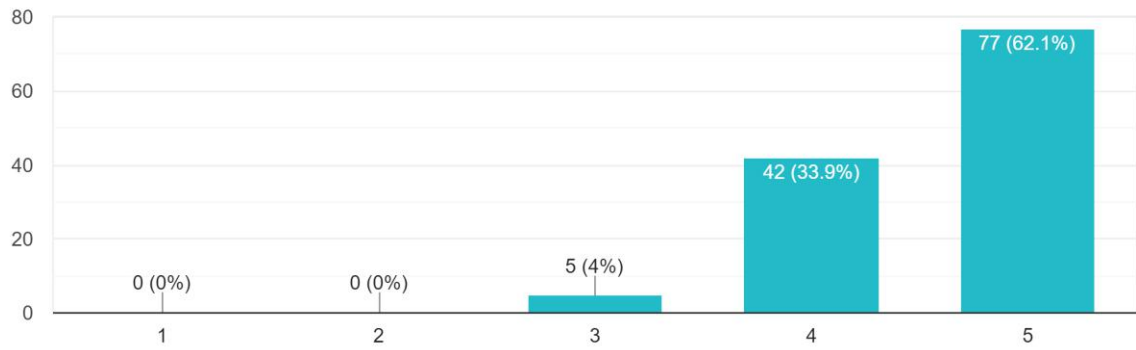

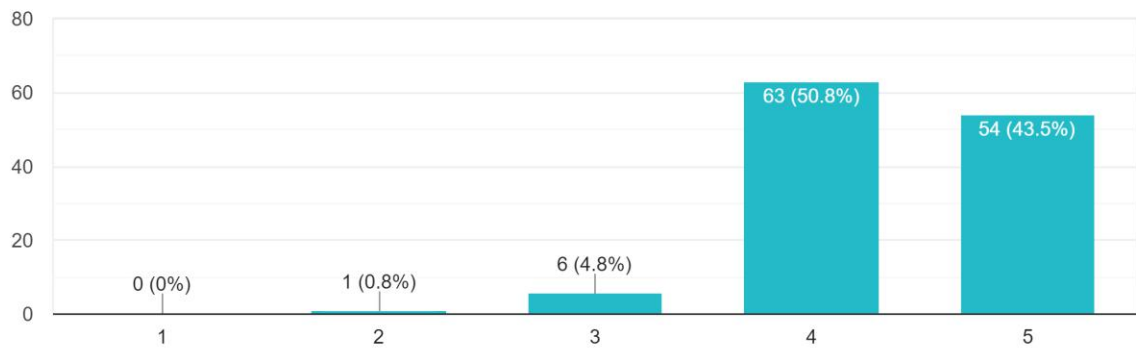

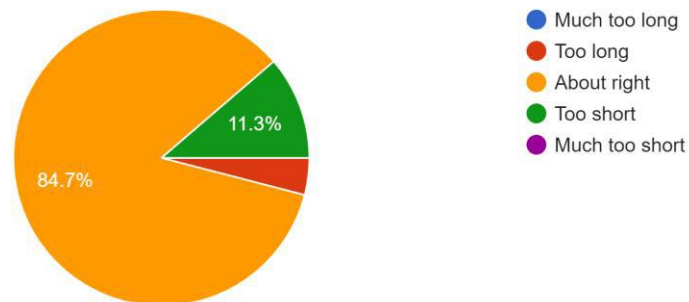
How would you rate the presenter on the subject matter?

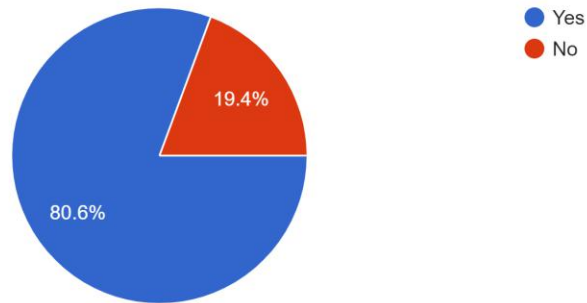
Was the event length too long, too short or about right?

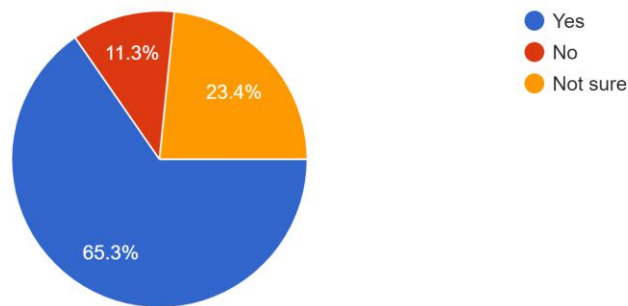
